The county clerk is a constitutional officer who is elected for a four-year term. In addition to issuing license plate registrations, the county clerk issues business licenses, marriage licenses, county beer permits, notary public at large commissions and passports. The county clerk also handles conservatorships, guardianships and the probating of estates (wills). As clerk of the Rutherford County Board of Commissioners, the County Clerk also keeps official minutes and records of the activities of the commission and the Rutherford County Beer Board.

The SEC serves as the TRP's state primary board and establishes to guide and direct County Republican Parties. One man and one woman are elected from each state senate district. The committeemen and committeewomen serve on the board and have a multitude of duties that keep them informed about all decisions made in the TRP. According to the Tennessee Republican Party, they are the liaison between the committee and their district. They attend and support Republican events, and are required to attend three annual meetings where they discuss the business of the TRP. They also assist in recruiting, advising, and supporting Republican candidates.

Heather Dawbarn Register of Deeds

The Register of Deeds has legislated responsibilities for the recording of and long-term preservation of documentation filed by law to convey notice of legally-protected real property rights and interests that directly affect Rutherford County local citizens' public interests. While those basic duties are relatively standardized nationwide, the Rutherford County Register of Deeds Office holds a very rare unique distinction. Funding is fully derived from patron fees rather than public taxpayer revenues and any surplus funds are promptly repaid to the county at end of affected budgetary FY.

The Rutherford County Circuit Court Clerk Melissa Harrell is an elected official who serves for a term of four years and is responsible for all filings, processing and final disposition of cases, which include several phases of the Civil and Criminal law procedures in the Juvenile, General Sessions (Civil & Criminal), Circuit Civil and Circuit Criminal Courts. The Circuit Court Clerk employs Chief Deputies and several deputy clerks in each court in order to fulfill the requirement to attend court sessions and perform all clerical functions of each court. 
Rob Mitchell Property Assessor

The Rutherford County Assessor of Property is required to locate, classify and set an appraised value on all taxable property located in Rutherford County and any improvements on it for assessment purposes according to the laws of the State of Tennessee. The exception being for public utility and railroad properties whose value is determined by the Office of State Assessed Properties. We currently have over 111,000 individual real property and approximately 13,000 business personal property accounts.

The Assessor's office is also responsible for determining the value of Tangible Personal Property, i.e., equipment, vehicles, electronics, etc. of businesses. This value is determined by filing a tangible personal property schedule with our office each year. The office hears property owner appeals relative to the value the office has set on their real and personal property. If the appeal cannot be resolved to the satisfaction of the property owner, appeals may be filed with the Rutherford County Board of Equalization Contact info: 615.898-7750 assessor@rutherfordcountytn.gov



Area Conventions

- Called by the current Area Vice Presidents "for the purpose of electing an Area Vice President and to take up any other business the convention delegates seem appropriate.
- At least ninety (90) days prior to the State Biennial Convention. That means that your Area Convention will take place before the July 24 deadline.
- Each club's delegates and alternates are based on its membership totals with "one delegate for every 10 memberships paid to the State Federation within 30 days after the Call to the Area Convention.

Delegates and alternates are to be elected by each club after due notice to the membership. Delegates and alternates must have been members at least (60) days before their election.


